

Nissan Bluetooth Bypass

In select Nissan vehicles the on hook, off hook, and P.T.T. buttons are routed through the factory Bluetooth, which is lost when the OE radio is removed. If you want to utilize the Bluetooth buttons on your steering wheel with an aftermarket radio you must bypass the factory Bluetooth module. Below is a list with the locations of the Bluetooth module and how to bypass it.

- 1. Locate the Bluetooth module.
- 2. Unplug the 32 pin harness from the Bluetooth module.
- 3. Connect pin 12 to pin 17 from the 32 pin connector.
- 4. Connect pin 13 to pin 18 from the 32 pin connector.
- 5. Connect pin 14 to pin 19 from the 32 pin connector.
- 6. After connections are made refer to the vehicle instruction for the ASWC to complete installation.
